The principal activity of SG Issuer is raising finance by the issuance of warrants as well as debt securities designed to be placed to institutional customers or retail customers through the distributors associated with Société Générale. The financing obtained through the issuance of such debt securities is then lent to Société Générale and to other members of the Group.

The Issuer is a 100% subsidiary of Société Générale Luxembourg S.A. who is itself a 100 % subsidiary of Société Générale and is consolidated by global integration.

In accordance with its bylaws, the Issuer is managed by an Executive Board under the supervision of a Supervisory Council. The members of the Executive Board are Laurent Weil, Thierry Bodson, Pascal Jacob, Yves Cacclin, Alexandre Galliche and Estelle Stephan Jaspard (each individually a Director and collectively the Executive Board). Laurent Weil, Thierry Bodson, Pascal Jacob, Yves Cacclin, Alexandre Galliche and Estelle Stephan Jaspard exercise their activities full time within Société Générale group.

1.2 Mechanism

1.2.1 *Index Composition*

Underlying Basket Component Weight, "W^N(i,t)" means, in respect of an Underlying Basket Component (i) and Calculation Date (t) that is Nth Rebalancing Date, the weight (expressed in percentage) of such Underlying Basket Component as effective on the close of such Rebalancing Date determined pursuant to Section 3.2.1.
